FORMAL REQUEST FOR THE PAYMENT OF 5% WHISTLEBLOWER COMPENSATION FOR INFORMATION FURNISHED IN RESPECT OF CRUDE OIL STOLEN FROM THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA.

We are Solicitors to SAMANO SA DE CV and have their instructions to write to your good self in respect of the above subject matter.

We have the instruction of our Clients to inform you as follows:

- Our Client is an oil and gas trading company with significant interest in 1.0 the oil refining business industry. Sometime in 2015, our Client was approached by a group in the Peoples' Republic of China ("China") with the intent to sell 48 million barrels of Bonny Light Crude Oil (the "Stolen Products"), believed to have been stolen from the Federal Republic of Nigeria ("Nigeria") and stored in various ports and terminals in China. It was revealed to our Client that the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation ("NNPC") authorised certain companies to sell the stolen products in China. [Attached are copies of documents to wit: Authorisation Letters by NNPC dated 6th July, 22nd July and 6th August 2015; Copies of Storage Information dated 16th May and 12th July, 2015; copies of Storage Certificate dated 16th May and 19th July, 2015; SS MAKAB STAR Tank Receipt dated 29th June, 2015; SS VISHAL STAR Tank Receipt dated 19th July, 2015; and Discharge Certificate dated 15th July, 2015. All documents are marked as annexures "A", "A1", "A2", "B", "B1", "C", "C1", "D", "E", and "F", respectively.]
- 1.1 It is general knowledge that corruption has eaten deep into the fabric of the Nigerian society and has now, over the years, become a bane to good governance and proper fiscal administration. This spurred the Buhari-led administration in 2016, in its fight against corruption within the Nigerian

- Government, to introduce the Whistle Blowing Policy (the "Policy") through an Executive Order.
- 1.2 Sequel to this policy, our Client, being a reputable and credible company, promptly brought to the knowledge of the Nigerian Government information as to criminal activity involving the NNPC and the stolen products. This information was given to high-ranking officials of the Nigerian Government to wit: Mr. Mele Kyari, the Managing Director of NNPC, Mr. Abba Kyari, the then Chief of Staff to the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria and Mr. Umar Mohammed.
- 1.3 Consequently, it was agreed that an investigation into the stolen products should be made to ascertain the veracity of the information and garner more facts as to the fraudulent activities. It was also agreed that if the information is found credible, the perpetrators of the offence will be apprehended and that compensation due to our Client for the information so brought forward will be awarded. Attached and marked as annexures "G" and "G1" are copies of photographs capturing meetings with Mr Mele Kyari on the stolen products.
- 1.4 Further to the above stated discussions, our Client, through its Chief Executive Officer, Mr Jose Salazar Tinajero (its "Representative"), wrote to His Excellency, President Muhammadu Buhari (the "President"), notifying him of the stolen products, as advised by the said high-ranking officials. The said letter was delivered to Mr Umar Mohammed who, to the surprise of our Client, failed to deliver it to the President. Attached and marked as annexure "H" is a copy of the Letter dated 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2015.
- 1.5 In October 2015, our Client got wind of the fact that the stolen products were being moved from their location in China by the Nigerian Government, in calculated steps, to recover the said products. Our Client then caused a letter to be written to Mr. Mele Kyari, through Mr. Marco Ramirez, offering to legally purchase the said products from the Nigerian Government if available for sale. Attached and marked as annexure "I" is a printed copy of the email correspondence dated 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2015.
- 1.6 Our Client, through its representative, subsequently wrote to Mr Umar Mohammed clarifying its intention to expose the criminal activity in respect of the stolen products and not to make illegal purchase of same.

  Attached and marked as annexure "J" is a copy of the Letter dated

- 4<sup>th</sup> November, 2015. To date, our Client has unfortunately not received any form of compensation for the information provided to Nigerian Government in respect of the stolen products and/or a response to its offer to legally purchase same when recovered.
- 1.7 The upright act of reporting the criminal activity to appropriate quarters, was not protected by the expected confidential nature of the Policy thereby exposing officials of our Client to serious consequences including threat to life, harassment, institutional discrimination and economic exclusion, reprimands, and other forms of persecution. All efforts made by our Client to receive compensation, including writing to the Senate of Nigeria, through the then Minority Leader, Senator Godswill Obot Akpabio and the Department of State Services in Nigeria (DSS), through the then Director-General, Mr Lawal Musa Daura, proved futile and thus, were to no avail. Attached is a copy of the Letter to Godswill Akpabio dated 17th May, 2017 and marked as annexure "K"; a copy of the Letter to Lawal Musa Daura dated 25th July, 2017 and marked as annexure "L"; and copies of Whatsapp conversations with Mr Mele Kyari marked as annexure "M", "M1" and "M2".
- 1.8 Our Client has documents including bank transfer details, names of vessels and their Captains to show that the stolen products have been illicitly sold by some officials of the Nigerian Government and the NNPC, who are involved in the implementation of the Presidential Directive to investigate matters pertaining to stolen crude oil. These documents will be made available on request.

### **CONCLUSION**

On the basis of the integrity of the Nigerian Government in its fight against endemic corruption, fairness and dire need to uphold assurances, we humbly urge you to use your good office to intervene promptly and remedy the situation by prevailing on the appropriate authority to pay the compensation legitimately due to our Client.

Please note that if after 14 days of the receipt of this letter, we do not receive a positive response to our Client's request, in respect of the payment of the whistle blower's compensation, we shall be constrained to proceed to the law court for the enforcement of the civil rights of our Client.

We look forward to your favourable response and assure you of our highest professional regards.







Two years ago (August 2015) handed over to people close to the President of Nigeria General Buhari MR ABBA KYARI, SR MELE KYARI and THE GENERAL UMAR MOHAMMED who were part of the committee specially created by President Buhari for the recovery of stolen oil information and documentation showing the location Exact oil stolen (48 mm bb) from NNPC and stored in tanks in China.

These people members of the committee offered me 5% of the value of the recovered oil in addition to the opportunity for my company to participate in the sale of the stolen oil.

The committee asked me to send a letter to President Buhari informing him of the situation, the letter was delivered to General MOHAMMED but this information was never given to President Buhari and was used by these people for their own benefit because in October and November 2015 all the petroleum documented in the information given to these people was sold.

In October of 2015, it was advised to SR MELE KYARI and GENERAL UMAR MOHAMMED that the stolen oil was being sold by NIGERIAN COMPANIES, receiving in their reply that the stolen oil was under their protection and that nobody could sell it.

I filed a legal-claim to obtain the benefit (5% of the value recovered) for having handed over the documents that helped to find the stolen oil, but no justice institution in Nigeria accepted my claim for fear of these people, as they currently occupy high Positions in the government of President Buhari.

I contact the actual Nigerian government committee (AG, DG DSS, DG NIA, DG NNPC) but did not accept my claim because they told me that the committee does not accept claims that occurred in 2015.

I have documents proving the existence and exact location in CHINA tanks of stolen oil.

Are more o less 100 documents that I have with names of boats, captains, receipts of tanks in China with the numbers of tanks, companies that took the oil, companies who sold the stolen oil, company, names of heads of NNPC who authorized output ships and names of those who authorized the ATS to sell the stolen oil.

I have WhatsApp emails and conversations with the highest NNPC and current committee leaders.

They accepted that if they abused my good faith but they have not wanted or been able to come to terms with me because of the situation of those who are in high positions of the current government.

Listen in the press that the Nigerian Senate has a committee looking for stolen oil or money that has produced the sale of that stolen oil.

I have the documentation and the people's names to whom I delivered the information of the exact location and who benefited from the sale of that stolen oil.

I put myself at your orders for any doubt , clarification or extension of this letter.

Receive my gratitude for the support received from you and the agency the DSS.


